Items to bring with you:

- Your own shotgun or rent one from Hunt's (they have 10 available).
Any shotgun that is in safe working condition, capable of firing two shots, may be used. Any gauge can be used, but the most popular are 12 and 20 gauge.
- Your own ammo (anticipate bringing 3 boxes)
- Eye and Ear protection will be necessary any time you are on a sporting clays course.

Make sure to use the proper ammo, both the proper gauge and the proper shell for what you are shooting.

The first consideration in shooting a round of sporting clays is always safety, and it starts as soon as you start to remove your shotgun from your vehicle. Make sure your gun is not loaded by opening the breech, and look down the barrel to check for obstructions. Keep the breech over to let everyone see that it is safe; if you have a over/under or side-by-side, carry it broken open with the muzzle down or up in the air.

At all times, treat the gun as if it is loaded.

Sporting Rules

Think Safety at All Times!!

You will start on your assigned first station and shoot each station in order.

- When your turn comes up to shoot, be ready.
- Step up to the station.
- Then and only then do you load your shotgun.
- Point it safely toward the target firing area.
- When your gun is ready and you are in position, relax and call pull.



If there is a malfunction or the gun does not fire, continue pointing the gun safely downrange. Then unload it or ask for assistance. The problem may be due to faulty ammo or a mechanical failure of the gun. If at any time a shot sounds light or different, stop immediately, unload, and check your barrel to make sure the wad has cleared and there are no obstructions.

Self Scoring: X = Hit, O = Miss. May shoot twice at Singles (RP) is once "A" has been fired at "B" is launched.

- Shoot only in station for safety.
- Keep all actions open when not in station.
- Load only 2 shells at a time.
- No shells larger than 12ga, 2 3/4, 7.5 shot.

When you are done shooting at a station:

- Open your gun.
- Remove the used hulls, and exit the station.
- Never move off a station until your gun is open and safe.
- Remain behind the station, out of the way, until all shooters have shot that station and are ready to move on.



At all times, treat the gun as if it is loaded.
